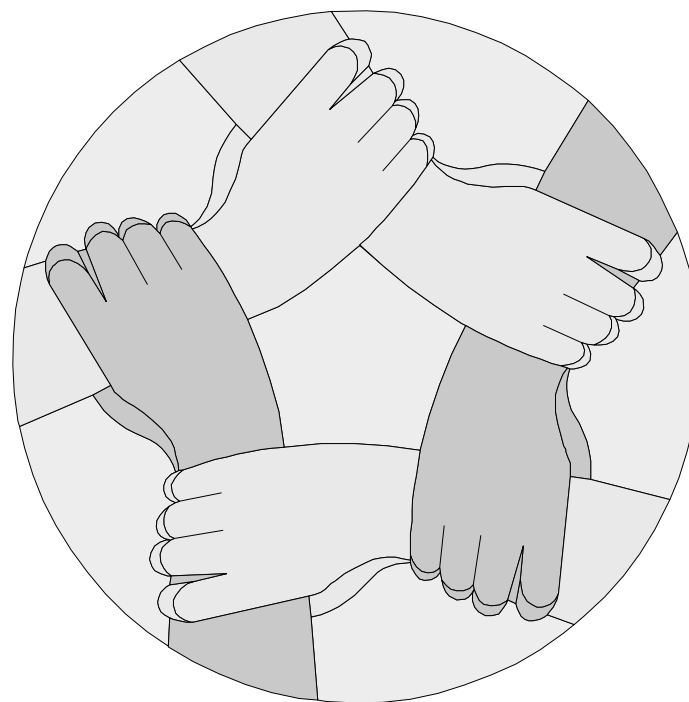

Parish ministry covers a wide spectrum of activities and subjects. Being a Parish Priest is often a time-consuming and difficult responsibility and to do justice to the position, a priest needs support from a variety of places. It cannot be done alone.

Prayer is basic to being a Christian. The Anglican Fellowship of Prayer (AFP) Canada can support a Parish Priest in many areas, some of which might not immediately come to mind when one mentions prayer. This pamphlet is intended to highlight some of the areas of parish ministry in which AFP has resources that a Parish Priest can use to enhance the spiritual life of the parish.

A primary area of parish ministry is to **encourage members of the parish to pray regularly**. AFP (Canada) has written and electronic resources in the form of pamphlets, booklets, books, handbooks, audio and video tapes, and prayer cards that can be used for corporate spiritual growth activities or provided to members of specific ministry groups. They could be made available as items in a parish library. Human resources, such as people to conduct or help in carrying out workshops, spiritual growth sessions and prayer events are also available.

Some specific areas in which AFP can provide written resources and suggestions/ideas/human resources are described in the following pages.



Things That A Parish Priest Might Want To Pursue

In order to take full advantage of what the Anglican Fellowship of Prayer can do in supporting the Parish Priest and the parish as a whole, one might want to consider pursuing some of the following things.

- ✠ Have your Parish become a member of AFP and receive regular AFP Newsletters.
- ✠ Contact and get to know your AFP Diocesan Representative.
- ✠ Appoint an AFP Parish Representative.
- ✠ Obtain information from your AFP Diocesan Representative or AFP Parish Representatives.
- ✠ Become a member of AFP (Canada) yourself.

- ✠ Ask your Diocesan Representative to organize a prayer workshop in your parish in cooperation with your Parish Representative.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✠ AFP's "Powerhouse of Prayer" workbook. ✠ AFP's "An Emmaus Walk" pamphlet. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✠ Ask your Diocesan Representative to organize, with your Parish Representative a parish workshop on prayer. ✠ Ask the AFP National Director to come to your Parish to lead an event, retreat or mission. ✠ Use AFP's "An Emmaus Walk" pamphlet as a resource for a walking meditation at a quiet day, retreat, Lenten exercise or as the conclusion to a study of the biblical story upon which it is based.

Support For Alpha Course

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✠ Your AFP Parish Representative or Diocesan Representative could give the Alpha talk on prayer, and/or act as discussion facilitator. ✠ Your AFP Parish Representative or Diocesan Representative could organize prayer support via ongoing Prayer Group prayers and/or special Prayer Vigil for the Alpha course before it starts.

Train & Organize Liturgical Intercessors and Readers

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✠ AFP's "Readers and Intercessors Handbook" 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✠ Using suggestions from AFP resources, ask your AFP Parish Representative, or other lay person, to coordinate the inclusion of parish concerns in the "Prayers of the People" in regular worship services. ✠ Give AFP's "Readers and Intercessors Handbook" to each Reader, and use it to inform and train Readers.

Personal Prayer Support for Parish Clergy

Confirmation Preparation

✠ "Anglican Learning Centres—Prayer" by Patricia Bays, Toronto: Anglican Book Centre.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✠ Your AFP Parish Representative or Diocesan Representative could arrange for a teaching session on prayer for the confirmation candidates as part of a preparation course. ✠ Your AFP Parish Representative could organize Prayer Partners from the parish to pray for each person who is to be Confirmed before and after the Confirmation.

Baptism Preparation

✠ AFP's two "Family Prayer" booklets.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✠ Your AFP Parish Representative or Diocesan Representative could arrange for a teaching session on prayer for the baptism candidates or their parents as part of a preparation course. ✠ Your AFP Parish Representative could organize Prayer Partners from the parish to pray for each person who is to be Baptized before and after the Baptism.
