FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD

A prayer pattern for each day

ADORATION (Praise God for who God is) "Holy, Holy, Holy. Lord God of Hosts; Heaven and earth are full of your glory; Glory be to thee, O Lord Most High."

CONFESSION

"If we confess our sins, he who is faithful and just will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9)

THANKSGIVING

"give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." (1 Thessalonians 5:18)

INTERCESSIONS

"But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be children of your Father in heaven; for he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the righteous and on the unrighteous." (Matthew 5:44-45

PETITIONS

"Ask, and it will be given you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you. For everyone who asks receives, and everyone who searches finds, and for everyone who knocks, the door will be opened." (Matthew 7:7-8)

SUNDAY

ADORATION:

Appreciate God's Power; soak in God's love for me; love God in return.

CONFESSION:

Things I've done amiss.

THANKSGIVING:

Bringing me to this point in my Christian life; promise for the future; move beyond doubt.

INTERCESSIONS:

May your name be holy in our congregation, friends, family, clergy, and leaders.

PETITIONS:

Committing a particular sae of life; opportunities to witness; guidance in studies and work; love and understanding for others.

MONDAY

ADORATION:

Allow God to enter into my being; love God back.

CONFESSION:

Things I've left undone.

THANKSGIVING:

His faithfulness; Christian friends; spiritual growth in others; health – body, mind, spirit.

INTERCESSIONS:

Women's groups; friends, family; human rights; congregational leadership; Christians undergoing persecution.

PETITIONS:

Direction for the future; spiritual refreshment; willingness to be used by God.

TUESDAY

ADORATION:

Sense the Light of God permeating all the dull areas of my life.

CONFESSION:

Falling short of God's expectations; be gentle with myself and allow God's forgiveness.

THANKSGIVING:

Spiritual infilling; human love; health; home, food clothing; the presence of the Holy Spirit.

INTERCESSIONS:

Children's ministries; family and friends; just solutions for people in need; Bible societies.

PETITIONS:

Increased faith; my contribution to the church; ability to relax and trust; opportunity to witness; guidance by the Holy Spirit.

WEDNESDAY

ADORATION:

Heavenly Father; God's love for me; I worship You.

CONFESSION:

My pride; not listening to God.

THANKSGIVING:

Gifts of the Holy Spirit; Attitude of Gratitude.

INTERCESSIONS:

Educators and teachers; theological colleges; Christian outreach.

PETITIONS:

Strength; freedom from bad habits and addictions; spiritual growth.

THURSDAY

ADORATION:

God's purpose; God's justice; God's kindness.

CONFESSION:

Difficult areas; trusting friend.

THANKSGIVING:

Safety; well-being; thanks for answers; God's promises.

INTERCESSIONS:

Those who are ill; those with addictions; youth; Bible and study groups; Christian education events.

PETITIONS:

Courage; wisdom; commitment; humility.

FRIDAY

ADORATION:

Wait expectantly and gently; praise God; see something new of God.

CONFESSION:

Broken relationships; forgiveness with guidance.

THANKSGIVING:

Assurance of forgiveness; blessings of increased relationship with God; spiritual healing.

INTERCESSIONS:

Men's groups; family and friends; political leaders; students.

PETITIONS:

Commit to follow Christ always; knowledge; courage; overcome temptation.

SATURDAY

ADORATION:

Praise for God's personal connection; God's continuing presence and guidance.

CONFESSION:

Identify hidden faults and resentments; missed opportunities to serve God.

THANKSGIVING:

Ability to work for Christ; looking for opportunities to thank God; thanksgiving for family and friends.

INTERCESSIONS:

Bishops, priests, deacons; Christian workers; my congregation.

PETITIONS:

Growth through Bible study; increased faith; resisting temptations; my parish and congregation.
